Detroit Metro Skating Council Grant Schedule For Individuals Attending Schools And Seminars Revised June 2008

One of the purposes of the DMSC is to foster national or international amateur competition in figure skating, and to promote the advancement of figure skating in the Detroit metropolitan area. To this end, DMSC may provide assistance to individuals who are members of DMSC Member Clubs, as follows:

1. Grants shall be used for schools and seminars for Judges, Referees, Accountants, Music Technicians, Ice Technicians, Announcers, Technical Panel, and other USFSA officials. The school or seminar must be sanctioned by USFSA.

2. Reimbursement:

- A. No cash advance are given
- B. Individual should request approval of the grant prior to the school or seminar
- C. Payment/reimbursement not to be made until documentation of successful completion is submitted to DMSC.

3. The individual must be a member in good standing of a DMSC member club.

4. Reimbursement may be awarded to help cover tuition/fees, reasonably necessary travel, and materials.

5. Maximum reimbursement generally not to exceed \$125 per person.

- 6. Schools or seminars *not hosted* by the DMSC:
 - Grant request must be submitted in writing to the DMSC within 30 days of completion of the school or seminar.

7. Grants requested are evaluated by the DMSC at a regularly scheduled meeting.

8. Criteria for approval or rejection is determined on a consistent individual basis only by the DMSC.

9. Grants for schools or seminars *hosted* by the DMSC or a DMSC member club are not eligible under this policy.
